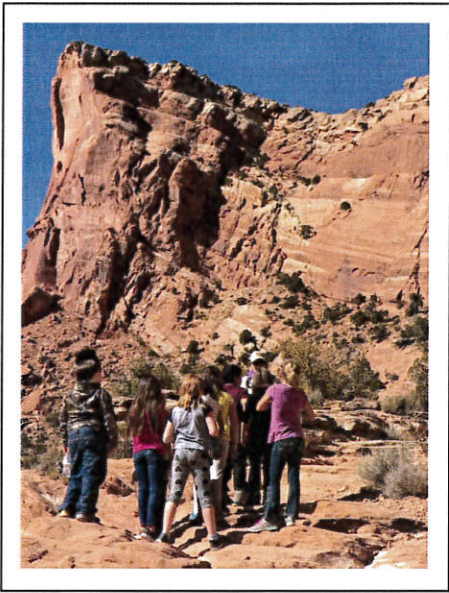
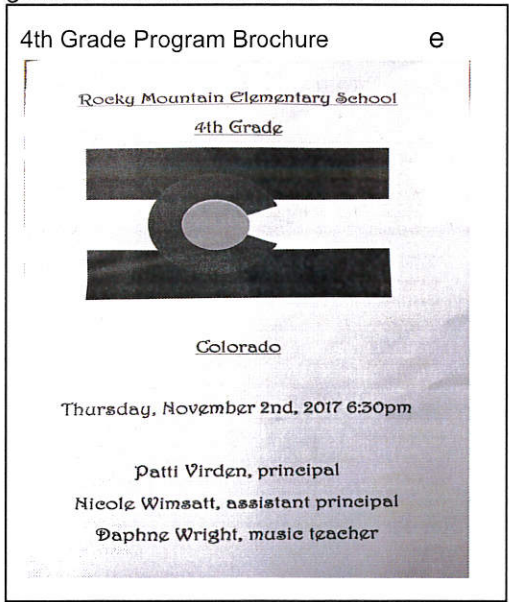
4th Grade Music Program
